

## Orange Heights Community Outreach

Our Purpose: Provide opportunities for our neighbors to get to know each other and give back to the community as families and neighbors by participating in community service projects together two to three times a year

Projects may include:

- Food, toy or clothing drives for Door of Hope, Union Station Family Shelter or other local charity – collection, sorting, delivery
- Working with Lake Avenue Foundation to provide and cook the main meal for one of their Sunday evening meals for homeless at Lake Avenue church

The guiding principles for our group as sanctioned by the Board:

- Under NO circumstances will association money be used for any purpose. Any event must be completely self-funded
- Organizations should be local – i.e. north of the 210 between Lake and Los Robles
- Events may be publicized via newsletter or other appropriate mechanism
- All events are completely voluntary and will be organized and run by the community service team
- Keep it simple and make it easy for people – leverage when people already getting together - perhaps night out
