Locking Trash and Recycling Bins

Neighbors have expressed concern about scavengers in their recycle and trash bins.

Locking recycle bins cost \$1.37 a month in addition to normal fees. If you would like to keep others out of your bins call

(626) 744 4449 or 744 4087 to inquire.

Laws vary for trash bins and recycling bins.

Recycling bins: Once the item is in the bin it belongs to the City of Pasadena. Rummaging through these is considered a Municipal Code Violation.

Trash bins: Once in the bin items are no longer private property. It is not illegal, according to the PPD, to rummage through these.

The best advice when discarding documents containing sensitive material (Social Security numbers, bank accounts numbers and/or personal information) is to shred them.

If you find unwanted scavengers rummaging through your recycle bins you can also call the non-emergency police number:

626 744 4241.

M.A.S.H services are free for qualified homeowners. Applicants must reside in the city of Pasadena and meet financial criteria imposed by the Housing and Urban Development Department.

The M.A.S.H. program offers home repair services including exterior painting of owner occupied homes, replacement of broken windows, rodent proofing and screen repair free of charge.

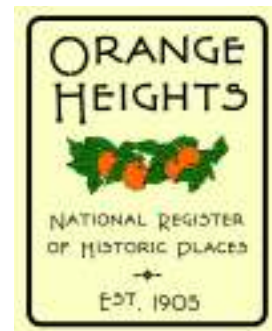
